

# Long Prairie –Grey Eagle Secondary School Grade Policy

## Grades

Students at Long Prairie-Grey Eagle Secondary School (LPGE) in grades 7 – 12 will earn letter grades based upon their performance in each of their courses. Grade marks earned are based upon percentages, which are listed below.

## Honor Roll

Honor Rolls are posted 5 days after the end of each quarter. To qualify for the A/A- Honor Roll, a student must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.67. To qualify for the B+/B Honor Roll, a student must have a GPA of at least 3.0. Students who have any grades lower than C- will not qualify for the Honor Roll. Honor Roll is based upon quarter GPA.

## Honor Students

To qualify to become an Honor Student you must have a Cumulative GPA of 3.50 for grades 9, 10, 11 and 1st semester of 12th grade. A list will be posted during the beginning of 2nd semester and students will be asked fill out an information sheet that will used for the local paper. Honor Students will receive a Gold Tassel at the Awards Program to be worn at graduation. Cumulative GPA is based upon semester GPA.

## Weighted and Un-weighted Grading

LPGE uses both weighted and un-weighted grading. Currently Advanced Placement (AP) courses are the only courses that use a weighted grading system. Current AP courses are listed below.

### Current Advanced Placement Courses at LPGE

- AP Biology, AP Literature and Composition and AP Photography
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## GPA and GPA Points

Both Quarter and Semester GPAs are based upon GPA points. Each Grade Mark has an assigned GPA point (chart listed below). Each course a student attempts will earn GPA points. To determine a GPA, add up all the earned GPA points and divide it by the number of attempted courses (regardless of pass or fail grade mark). Examples are listed below:

Student 1 attempted six courses and earned the following grades: C, B, C-, B+, F, and C. The student did not take any AP courses. The student earned 12 GPA points. You would then divide 12 GPA points by 6 attempted courses for a GPA of 2.00

Student 2 attempted 7 courses and earned the following grades: C, B+, A-, A, B+ (AP), B, and C+. The student earned 21.9993 GPA points. You would then divide 21.9993 GPA points by 7 attempted courses for a GPA of 3.142.
