

Data Practices Notice
“Tennessee” Warning

- You are being interviewed to talk about a report of an incident that involved potentially involved behavior prohibited by the School’s Bullying Prohibition Policy.
- The information you give during this interview may or will be used:
 - To determine what happened;
 - To determine what to do about it; and/or
 - In later hearings or proceedings.
- The decision about what happened and what to do in response may be made by the person interviewing you, or others at School or the School District.
- Other people or entities might have a right to have the information you provide. This could include School Administrators or Teachers; District Officials; Hearing Officer; Minnesota Department of Education; State and federal courts; law enforcement agencies and prosecutorial authorities; persons or entities whom you authorize to receive the data and; any other person or entity authorized by state or federal law.
- You are not legally required to provide any information during this interview. If you do not provide information in this interview, a decision will still be made, but without information from you.
- If you provide information, we will use the information to determine what happened and what to do about it and expect the information to be true.
